The NLC is a Crown agency of the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador providing safe and secure access to alcohol and non-medical cannabis products to the people of the province.

The NLC employs nearly 600 staff throughout the province and oversees the operation of different lines of business including liquor stores, a bottle and blending plant, and Cannabis NL.

Reporting to the Board of Directors, the CEO is responsible for all activities of the NLC including the importation, sale and distribution of beverage alcohol, and non-medical cannabis in NL. The CEO implements the mandate which includes advocating for intelligent consumption by informing customers and clients about the responsible and safe use of alcohol

and non-medical cannabis products. The CEO must support a passion for customer service, strong business performance, and progressive corporate culture, while developing effective client relationships. The CEO will be responsible for media relations.

The NLC is looking for an experienced business leader with a global mindset. The CEO must demonstrate strategic vision and planning with experience in leading sound fiscal management. As well, an understanding of accountancy, business management, and finance in a commercial enterprise or corporation is required.

The CEO must have knowledge and awareness of the social responsibilities attached to the selling of alcohol and non-medical cannabis. Effective decision

making, change management, collaboration, and communication skills are required. Demonstrated leadership skills are also required. Knowledge of public administration is an asset.

Qualifications for this position would normally be acquired through completion of a university degree in a business related discipline combined with considerable years of relevant progressively responsible experience in management and senior leadership. A master's degree would be preferred. Equivalencies will be considered.
